Frogtown/Summit-University (FSU)

Bethel University has initiated a grant program for students living in the FSU area. Applicants are eligible for up to \$1,500 of grant money per term depending on financial need. The criteria for this grant are listed below and will be effective through the 2009–2010 school year.

Qualifying Criteria

Applicants must:

- Apply to one of Bethel University’s College of Adult & Professional Studies programs and be accepted
- Live in the Frogtown/Summit-University neighborhood
- Demonstrate financial need as determined by the Bethel University Financial Aid Office by completing a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- Have an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of less than \$10,000 (determined by FAFSA)
- Apply for financial aid no later than 30 days after beginning of term for which the applicant hopes to receive the FSU grant
- Maintain satisfactory academic progress
- Take at least six credits per term
- Not be in default of any student loans
- Not have earned a bachelor’s degree
