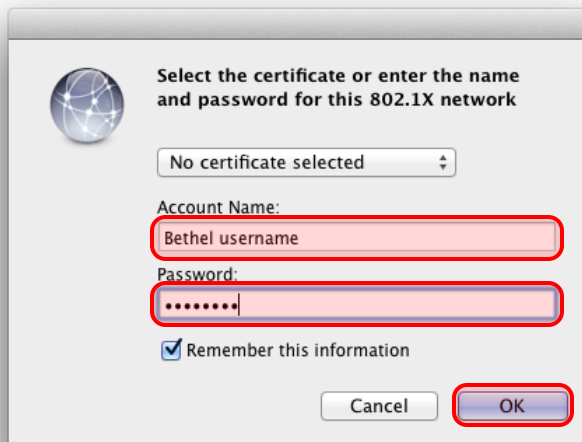


# OS X 10.7: Setting Up a Secured Wired Connection

## Step 1

Plug the **Ethernet** cable into to wall data port and your computer's ethernet port.

A authenticate box will appear if the port is 802.1x enabled. Enter your **Bethel Username** and **Password** in the appropriate fields, and select **OK**.



## Step 2

If you entered your **Bethel Username** and **Password** correctly you will then be asked to **verify a certificate**.

Click **Continue** and enter your Computer Account's **Username** and **Password**. Then click **Update Settings**.

You should now have a secure wired 802.1x connection on your Macintosh OS X 10.7 machine.
