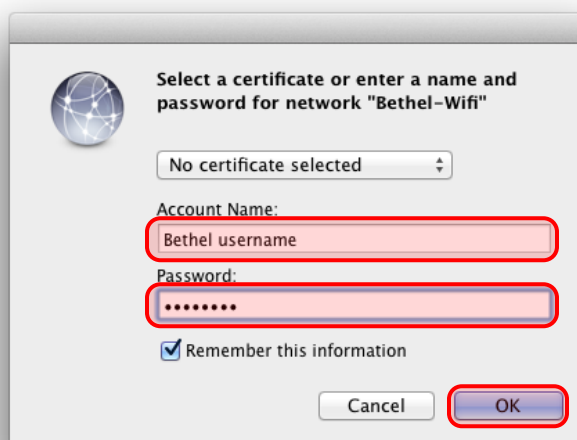
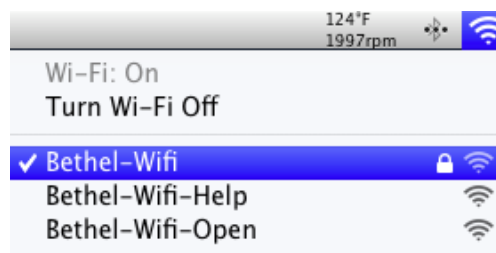


OS X 10.7: Setting Up a Secured Wireless Connection

Step 1

Click the Airport icon and select **Bethel-Wifi**. In the authentication window enter your **Bethel Username** and **Password** in the appropriate fields, and select **OK**.

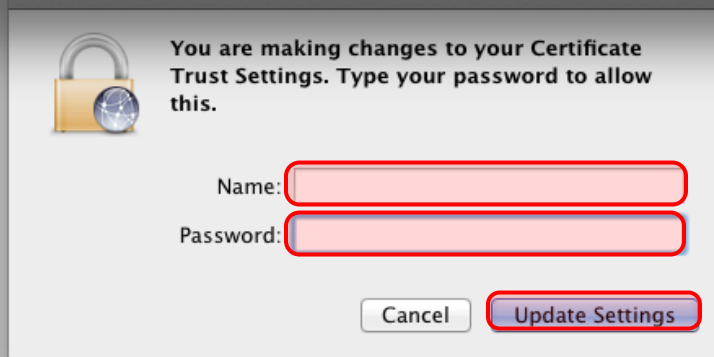


Step 2

If you entered your **Bethel Username** and **Password** correctly you will then be asked to **verify a certificate**.

Click **Continue** and enter your Computer Account's **Username** and **Password**. Then click **Update Settings**.

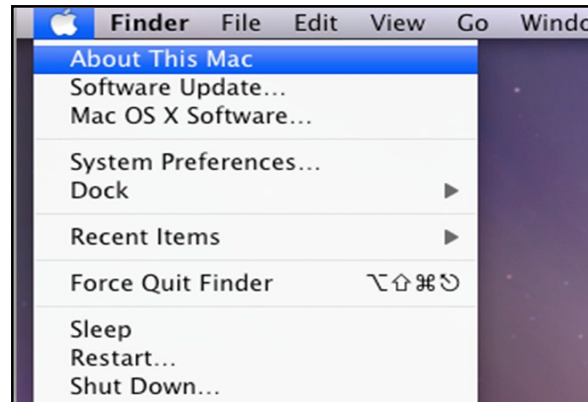
You should now have a secure wireless 802.1x connection on your Macintosh OS X 10.7 machine.



Determining My OS X Version

Step 1

Click the **Apple** in the upper left-hand corner of the screen, and select **About This Mac**.



Step 2

Under Mac OS X you will see your version number. **Only the first two numbers matter** (Ex. 10.5 or 10.4).
