

Simple Present

I **play** tennis.
Cats **like** milk.
The train **leaves** tonight at 6 PM.
I **am** here now.



Simple Past

I **saw** a movie yesterday.
I **lived** in Brazil for two years.
I **studied** French when I was a child
She **was** shy as a child, but now she is very outgoing.



Present Perfect

I **have seen** that movie twenty times.
I **have seen** that movie six times **in the last month**.
I **have had** a cold for two weeks.



Present Progressive

You **are learning** English now.
I **am studying** to become a doctor.
I **am meeting** some friends after work.
She **is always coming** to class late.



Past Perfect

I did not have any money because I **had lost** my wallet.

By the time Alex finished his studies,
he **had been** in London for over eight years.

She **had visited** her Japanese relatives once in
1993 before she moved in with them in 1996.
