



Questions to Ask in an Interview

Learn about the role

- Can you describe a typical day for me if I was to get this position?
- What skills or qualities are most important to have to be successful in this role?
- What are the most immediate projects that I would take on?

Learn about the employer

- What are the most important company values?
- What are the biggest goals for the company?
- How does this team/role contribute to the company's goals?
- What are the company's plans for growth and development?

Learn about the team

- Can you tell me about the team I will be working with?
- Who will I work with most closely? What other departments or units will I interact with?
- What is your leadership style? (if talking with who you would report to directly)

Learn about the Interviewer's experience

- How long have you worked here? Have you had any other roles?
- Why did you choose to work at this company?
- What do you enjoy most about working at this job? At this company?

Learn about the company culture

- How would you describe the company's culture?
- What is something unique that you like about the company?
- Has the company changed since you were hired? How?
- What kind of team/company events do you have?

Learn about Professional development

- What professional development opportunities are available to employees?
- What are the advancement opportunities in this role?
- Have employees previously in this role advanced in the company? What roles are they currently in?

Learn about the NExt steps

- What are the next steps in the interview process?
- When can I expect to hear from you?
- Is there anything else I can give you that would be helpful in making a decision?
