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SUMMARY

ACCOMPLISHMENTS

LEADERSHIP AND MANGAGEMENT

- Supervised a staff of 10 nurses, 15 nursing assistants, and 10 medical technicians by scheduling an efficient work schedule and ensuring quality patient care
- Instituted a computerized cardiac registry to compare clinical outcomes to national norms. Enabled the hospital to provide data to multiple payers with differing quality indicators.
- Resolved transition problems as the hospital liaison to Medica when ABC became their exclusive Minneapolis, MN, hospital. Patient surveys show above average satisfaction.
- Collaborated with other managers to write a cardiac business plan focused on efficiency.
- Execution of the plan will make United attractive in the era of integrated service networks.
- Established the Clinical Monitoring Team to assist physicians with invasive procedures. Physicians value the team's expertise and elimination of expensive outside agency.
 - Established alternative treatment protocols for dialysis and ventilator patients. Reduced cost and length of stay in intensive care.
 - Collaborated with physicians and hospital staff to develop clinical pathways. Quality of care is maintained. Cost and length of stay have decreased.
 - Proposed a new philosophy which involved families in cardiac rehabilitation. Received corporate approval for the construction of an exercise and education family center.

- Marketed the Health ABC Program (i.e., EKG over-reading service for rehabilitation programs in remote hospitals). Program has expanded and currently operates at capacity.

- Presented the topics of "Healthcare Reform" and "Children in Healthcare" at education symposiums.

 - Merged work groups, policies, and procedures because of multiple hospital consolidations.

OPERATIONS

- Represented nursing administration on the hospital steering committee to redesign care delivery. The patient-centered care model was selected and implementation is underway.
- Coordinated the nursing department preparations for the Joint Commission accreditation survey. Accreditation was received without citation.
- Established selection criteria for a \$1 million monitoring system. Involved staff in decision process and negotiated purchase terms.
- Directed several reconstruction projects involving remodeling of patient rooms. Assured that architectural plans met clinical needs and budget.
- Coordinated the hospital's response plan for emergencies. Developed strategies for all hospital departments and personnel.
 - Negotiated external contracts for dialysis. Service has improved and cost per treatment has decreased 15%.
