

SCLA Scholarship

(Senior Care Leadership and Administration Scholarship)

In order to play an integral role in delivering ethical, compassionate healthcare to one of the demographics that needs it most, Bethel University is proud to offer two unique scholarships: the SCLA Certificate Scholarship and the SCLA Internship Scholarship.

There are two SCLA Scholarship options:

- Certificate Scholarship for CAPS students enrolled for at least 6 credits (half-time) per semester: \$800 per semester for 3 consecutive semesters, \$2,400 total
- Internship Scholarship for CAS and CAPS students: \$1,600 for 2 consecutive semesters, \$3,200 total.

Requirements:

CAPS students must:

1. Be admitted to the College of Adult and Professional Studies (CAPS) and actively pursuing the Senior Care Leadership Administration certificate and/or internship.
2. Enroll for at least 6 credits (half-time) per semester. Students will not receive the scholarship during the semesters enrolled less than 6 credits.

NOTE: Recipients of the SCLA scholarship are not eligible for other Bethel-funded grants or scholarships.

CAS students must:

1. Submit the Dual Enrollment Application (<https://www.bethel.edu/registrar/forms/dual-enrollment-application>) and be approved for the SCLA internship.
2. Register for two consecutive semesters of SCLA internship.

All students must:

1. Complete the SCLA scholarship application (see reverse) and submit it to the Bethel University Financial Aid Office prior to the start of their first class or internship.
2. Maintain satisfactory academic progress (www.bethel.edu/adult-undergrad/financial-aid/eligibility/academic-progress).

Can CAS students apply for the SCLA Certificate Scholarship? No. CAS students are considered dual enrolled in both CAS and CAPS while taking the SCLA coursework, so are only eligible for normal CAS financial aid package.

Can students borrow educational loans during the internship? No. Students may borrow loans while taking courses leading to the SCLA certificate. However, the internship courses are not part of the certificate, and are therefore not eligible for loans.
