## **Growing Representation in Social Work Scholarship**

Bethel has created the Growing Representation in Social Work Scholarship to encourage underrepresented populations in the social work profession.

Two recipients will be selected for this competitive \$5,000 scholarship for the 2025-2026 academic year. The scholarship is not renewable, but students may reapply for the scholarship in subsequent years. If selected for a scholarship, the funds will be evenly split between fall, spring and summer semesters.

## Recipients must:

- 1. Be a current student pursuing the Master of Social Work degree *or* admitted to begin the Master of Social Work degree program for Fall of 2025.
- 2. Complete the scholarship application and submit it to Bethel's Social Work Department by the deadline of April 15, 2025.
- 3. Enroll at least half time (3 credits per semester in courses required for the student's program of study.
- 4. Maintain Satisfactory Academic Progress.

Eligibility Requirements: Recipients do not need to demonstrate need, and are not eligible for other Bethel-funded grants or scholarships. Students already receiving gift assistance from any source (including military benefits) that fully meets tuition are not eligible for this scholarship.
