

Thank you for your interest in the School Social Work Scholarship. This scholarship is designed to support students dedicated to the social work profession who demonstrate financial need and a commitment to school social work. The School Social Work Scholarship awards are available for up to \$15,000 per student, depending on financial need, enrollment status, and available funding. Once selected as a recipient of the scholarship, funds will be distributed over multiple semesters as outlined on award letter. Please complete all sections of this application accurately and thoughtfully.

Application deadline for round one of scholarship award: November 30, 2025, by 11:59PM

Application deadline for round two of scholarship award: March 31, 2026, by 11:59PM

Eligibility: To be considered for the School Social Work Scholarship, student's must:

- Be admitted to and enrolled in, or actively applying to the BSW or MSW at Bethel University
- Maintain <u>Satisfactory Academic Progress</u> throughout the duration of the award.
- A minimum GPA of 2.25 or higher for BSW; for MSW a minimum GPA requirement of 3.0 or higher
- BSW undergraduate students must have junior standing and be enrolled in a minimum of 12 credits per semester. Undergraduate students enrolling in summer courses are eligible for funding if enrolled in at least 2 credits.
- MSW graduate students must be enrolled at least half time (3 credits per semester). Graduate students who wish to enroll during the summer can receive funding if they are enrolled for at least 2 credits.
- Commit to practicum placement experiences that align with justice-informed social work values and community engagement and be placed within a Minnesota school.
- Complete the scholarship application and must be received by Bethel's Social Work Department by the deadline of November 30th, 2025, by 11:59PM.

Requirements: Recipients of the School Social Work Scholarship must agree to the following:

- Continue enrollment in the program each semester of the award period.
- Participate in program events, workshops, or professional development opportunities supported by the scholarship.
- Uphold the ethical and professional standards of the social work profession.
- Students will be required to commit to practicum placements in a Minnesota school setting. If a school-based setting cannot be identified then a school-linked placement instead.
- Students must commit to working in a Minnesota school-based social work position for the number of
 years commensurate to the number of years they received funding.

Priority will be given to new students or those who have not received School Social Work Scholarship funding, but all students are welcome to apply. Recipients do not need to demonstrate need. Bethel may need to reduce institutionally-controlled aid and/or other outside aid to prevent an overaward.
