
- 1) Log onto your my.bethel.edu account.
- 2) Click on the “Checklist” tab on the top of the page.
- 3) Scroll down the page and click on the blue “Financial Aid Offer” button.

- 4) On this Self-Service Banner Financial Aid page, click on the “[Award Offer](#)” tab and make sure you’ve selected the correct academic year.





- 6) Next, scroll down to the “Options to Pay Net Cost” section to view your offered loan eligibility. Here, if applicable, you will have the ability to accept or decline your loan eligibility.

Important Notes:

- You have the option to modify the loan amount(s) you would like to borrow via the “Take Action” dropdown menu. The amount you accept will default to split evenly between terms, so if you would like uneven fund distributions, please contact our office at finaid@bethel.edu.
- By accepting the PLUS/private loan eligibility, this notifies our loan team that you intend to submit a separate online application for a PLUS loan or a private loan.

- 7) Make sure to click on the blue “Submit” button once you have made your decision(s).
