


CAS Student Satisfaction with Core Elements of Their Experience at Bethel: Trends Over Time

Summary: Toward the end of each spring semester, we ask CAS students to complete the Campus Life Survey (a homegrown survey). There are a set of items that ask about student satisfaction with the some of the core elements of their experience at Bethel. For the most part, these ratings have been fairly stable over time. However, there are a few core areas that have received lower ratings recently.

Satisfaction with *General Education* has taken a noticeable downturn after 2020. Academic *Advising ratings* also decreased starting in 2021. However, the advising ratings are still better than the ratings 10-years ago. Other areas to watch are *instruction in the major* ratings (lower in 2023 but still solid) and overall educational experience ratings (again, lower in 2023 but still solid). Below are the satisfaction ratings in each core area from students over the past 6 years (2018-2023) and ratings from 10-years ago (2013).

On the Campus Life Survey we also ask students to rate the academic challenge (rigor) of their major and the academic support they receive in their major. During 2020 and after, the academic challenge ratings decreased significantly. In many ways this is not surprising given the changes that took place in response to Covid-19. The academic support ratings also went down in 2020 & 2021 but rebounded in 2022 & 2023.




How satisfied are you with your overall educational experience at Bethel? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale

The ratings from 2021 and 2023 are lower than we typically see for this key item. If it remains low next year, one plan would be to engage in some focus groups with students to probe for reasons for the lower ratings.

Thinking about your education at Bethel, how satisfied are you with:




How satisfied are you with your Bethel Community Life Experience? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale

These ratings have remained stable, except for 2021. Given all of the extra Covid-19 precautions in 2021, the lower ratings for that year are not surprising.

Thinking about your education at Bethel, how satisfied are you with:




How satisfied are you with Bethel's environment to help your spiritual growth? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale

The spiritual growth ratings have rebounded from the low ratings of 2021. Ratings in this area have been pretty stable. We had the exact same mean in 2023 as in 2013.




How satisfied are you with your General Education courses at Bethel? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale

Thinking about your education at Bethel, how satisfied are you with:




How satisfied are you with the academic advising you have received? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale

The academic advising ratings have decreased significantly since the peaks of 2018-2020. However, the current ratings are still better than 10-years ago.

Thinking about your education at Bethel, how satisfied are you with:




How satisfied are you with your overall educational experience in your primary major? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale




How satisfied are you with the faith integration you have experienced in the courses in your primary major? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale

Faith integration ratings remain strong and are significantly higher than 10-years ago.

How satisfied are you with the quality of instruction in the classes in your major? 1 = very dissatisfied to 7 = very satisfied scale

Ratings for instruction in the major were lower in 2021 and 2023. Given that 2022 ratings were strong, hopefully the 2021 and 2023 ratings were just aberrations.


Academic Challenge. Current students are asked "Do you feel you were challenged enough academically in your primary major?" They respond to this item on a 1 (not at all) to 7 (definitely) scale.

Ratings for academic challenge have decreased since Covid-19. This is not too surprising given the accommodations that faculty were forced to make to adjust for online learning and distancing in classrooms.

Support

Current students and alumni are asked "Do you feel you received enough support in your primary major or program?" They respond to this item on a 1 (not at all) to 7 (definitely) scale. Surprisingly, current students give lower ratings for support compare to alumni.

Academic support ratings have increased significantly since 2021.
