

BETHEL UNIVERSITY (CAS) GENERAL EDUCATION TRANSFER GUIDE 2020-2021

This transfer guide is designed to help a student at **Inver Hills Community College** easily and confidently choose courses to take at Inver Hills that will satisfy Bethel University's general education (core curriculum) requirements. Unless otherwise indicated, one (1) course from each area will satisfy the general education requirement listed. In most cases, with careful planning you will be able to fulfill Inver Hills curriculum objectives while also completing coursework Bethel requires. Contact Bethel or Inver Hills for assistance with your planning.

Students who plan to transfer 30 or more credits to Bethel may be exempt from certain general education requirements at Bethel. Students who complete the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum or an Associate of Arts degree before entering Bethel will be exempt from several requirements. - Inver Hills courses listed under more than one Bethel Requirement category can only count once. Students can choose which category they prefer.
- A grade of 'C' or higher is required on each course in order for the transfer credit to be accepted by Bethel.
- An official transcript must be sent to Bethel once the course is completed and the grade has been posted.
