Work with Purpose Sermon Competition: Preparation

Key Dates:

- Registration opens August 1, 2017
- Registration closes September 1, 2017
- Sermons must be delivered between September 1 and December 31, 2017
- Preaching report submissions due no later than January 31, 2018
- Grand prizes awarded on or before February 28, 2018

Sermon Guidelines: The sermon or teaching must be delivered in an actual church setting, but not necessarily from a Sunday morning pulpit. It can be a delivered to a group of people (weekly service, house church, special gathering, etc.) to whom the pastor plays a pastoral or teaching role. The sermon must also have a clear intent to inspire, encourage, or empower the listener toward a clearer vision of faith, work, and economics. The sermon should also be no longer than approximately 20 minutes in length. See the judging rubric for additional guidelines.

Preaching Report Requirements:

- Video of complete sermon
- Sermon notes or outline
- PowerPoint slides (if applicable)
- Minimum of 3 completed congregant evaluations (see below)
- Written report of pastor experience that includes response to congregant evaluations

These items are due *no later than* January 31, 2018. All submitted artifacts will be shared with partners in Work with Purpose Initiative's network (including the Kern Family Foundation) at the discretion of Work with Purpose staff.

Congregant Evaluations:

Download and distribute the <u>Sermon Competition Congregant Evaluation</u> to listeners. A minimum of 3 completed forms must be included in the Preaching Report.

Preaching Report Submission Tips:

Videos must be recorded in file formats supported by YouTube. <u>View list of supported formats</u>. Video files will be submitted to Work with Purpose via a Dropbox account. All other items can be emailed to Work with Purpose at <u>work-with-purpose@bethel.edu</u>.
