Job Purpose:

- Oversee pastoral staff including administering performance reviews in conjunction with the board of elders.
- Be available to all ministry leaders for advice, encouragement and perspective about the overall purpose and direction of the church.
- Provide and/or delegate counseling to church members and attendees as requested.
- Provide home visitation services to church members and attendees as needed or requested.
- Conduct marriage and funeral services as requested by church members and attendees as approved by the board of elders.

Skills/Qualifications:

- **Mature Follower of Jesus Christ:** Has a personal testimony of a relationship with Jesus and meets the qualifications of an elder in character as outlined in 1 Timothy and Titus, and in action as outlined in 1 Peter 5.
- **Heart of a Shepherd:** Has a deep desire to connect with an intergenerational congregation at a personal, one-on-one level while biblically counseling and discipling church members and attendees toward growth and wisdom in Jesus.
- **Passion for Sharing the Gospel:** Seeks to engage the local community by exhorting church members and attendees to evangelism in their spheres of influence and leads by example.
- **Passion for God's Word:** Has a deep understanding of the Bible, can answer difficult questions, is not afraid to teach on difficult passages of Scripture, can teach both topically and expositionally, and is still humble enough about being wrong.
- **Leadership with Humility:** Leads courageously while maintaining the humility of a team player willing to receive counsel and work within the existing team and culture.
- **Excellent Oral and Written Communication Skills:** Communicates effectively in multiple contexts, including one-on-one counseling, leading small group discussions, preparation of teaching materials, and teaching large groups.
- **Biblical Education:** A bachelor's degree in biblical studies or a related field preferred.
- **Called by the Lord:** Views the pastoral ministry not as a job or a business, but as a calling from the Lord outside of the usual occupational framework.
