Job Summary:

The Chinese Ministry Pastor will join the pastoral team and be responsible for the overall Chinese ministry (CM) of the church, including adults, seniors and youth. The CM congregations are mostly immigrants from Hong Kong, totaling around 150 regular attendees. The CM Pastor alongside other pastor(s) oversees the worship, discipleship, fellowship and evangelism of the Chinese ministry.

Job Description:

A. Worship

- Oversee the worship services.
- Provide guidance and assistance in training worship leaders and worship teams.
- Preach on a regular basis.

B. Discipleship

- Equip fellowship counselors, group leaders, Sunday school teachers, and future leaders through mentorship and training.
- Chinese Sunday School
 - Oversee and direct the growth of Chinese Sunday School.
 - Select and approve appropriate curriculum.
 - Recruit and support Sunday School teachers.
 - Teach Sunday School classes as need arises.

C. Fellowship

- Recruit, support, and provide consultation to fellowship group leaders..

- Oversees the women ministry, which consists of small groups and outreach programs.
- Attend different fellowship groups, and lead as needed.
- Work with department heads to oversee the daily operation of the church..
- Assist in caring for fellowship members.

D. Evangelism

- Lead and encourage local outreach to the Chinese community.
- Together with the pastoral team, support, promote and arrange for mission work in the church.

E. Caring ministry

- Coordinate with church leaders with church caring ministry.
- Visit and provide care to members through different life events (baptisms, funerals, weddings, illness, etc.).
- Provide or arrange crisis counseling, premarital counseling or other personal counsellings to members in need.

F. Participate in additional duties as assigned by the Senior pastor.

Reports to: Senior Pastor

Works with: Pastoral staff, Administrative staff, Deacons, Department Heads, Fellowship and group leaders.
