1. SPA203 and SPA204 Intensive Intermediate Spanish I and II in Guatemala may be taken in lieu of SPA201 and SPA202 during the sophomore or junior year.
2. All Spanish majors must have a semester-long experience in a Spanish-speaking setting outside the United States. Courses taken during the semester abroad are determined by year of study and student's level.
3. Required in Guatemala term Program only.
4. Students with previous experience in Spanish take a placement exam to determine which class is appropriate for their level of language competency. This class indicated by this exam should be taken during their first semester at Bethel.
5. Meet with director of internship and placement at least two terms before beginning internship.

This program assumes a student will use SPA301U to meet the general education World Cultures requirement. All language course 102 level and higher will meet the Language General Education requirement. Double Majors should consult with their adviser for the second major to avoid sequencing problems. Most financial aid packages stipulate 12 credits/semester; Minnesota state grants are reduced when credit load falls below 25 credits/semester. (Interim credits may be split between fall and spring for state grant purposes only.)
