3. Students must meet with director of internship and placement at least two terms before beginning internship.

This program assumes a student will use [THA100A](#), [THA291L](#), and [PEA114QA](#) or [PEA115QA](#) to meet the general education Nature of Persons, Contemporary Western Life and Thought, and Leisure and Lifetime Sports requirements. Most financial aid packages stipulate 12 credits/semester; Minnesota state grants are reduced when credit load falls below 15 credits/semester. (Interim credits may be split between fall and spring for state grant purposes only.)
