



INTERIM ABROAD SCHOLARSHIP PROCESS

Description: This competitive scholarship pays for half of the cost of interim tuition charged to seniors who are not enrolled as full-time students in the academic year during which they plan to participate in a Bethel faculty-led study abroad interim course. To help cover the cost of the additional interim tuition charge, a limited number of scholarships will be awarded.

Eligibility: Eligibility for this scholarship is limited to seniors who:

1. have not studied abroad in a semester or interim abroad program since enrolling at Bethel;
2. will graduate in December or are part-time in the fall and/or spring semester the year in which they graduate; and
3. intend to study abroad in a Bethel faculty led interim abroad program during their senior year.

Additional Considerations:

1. In reviewing applications, priority will be given to those who have not studied abroad previously.
2. Scholarship recipients are responsible for all costs associated with the interim study abroad program.
3. In the event a scholarship is awarded to a student who does not study abroad as planned, the scholarship may be awarded to another applicant.

Application Process:

1. Students must submit the scholarship application form to cas-academic-affairs@bethel.edu by **April 1 of the academic year prior to the interim in which they plan to study abroad.** The application is available [here](#) under “helpful quick links.”

Review of Applications:

1. Applications will be reviewed by the deans in the Office of Academic Affairs in the College of Arts & Sciences.
2. Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.
3. Recommendations will be made to the Office of Financial Aid for the scholarship recipients for approval.
4. The Office of Academic Affairs will notify students of the scholarship selection by **April 15 of the academic year prior to the interim in which they plan to study abroad.**
