Senate: Policy Change Principles

The general principles to be followed for policy changes that would have been forwarded to the Faculty as a whole in the old faculty governance system should be as follows:

Academic Policies

- 1. Policy is considered by Academic Policies Committee (APC).
- 2. Policy, with any changes made by APC, is forwarded to the Committee for Academic Affairs (CAA) for consideration
- 3. CAA reports back to APC by means of a vote to endorse or reject the policy, or a referral back to APC for further consideration.
- 4. APC makes a motion to the Senate for the change, including rationale and CAA responses.

Curricular Policies

- 1. Policy is considered by CAA or General Education Committee
- 2. CAA or General Education Committee votes on the policy

If the policy is approved by the CAA or General Education Committee, the committee makes a motion to the Senate for the change, including rationale.
