## ACBSP Baccalaureate Business Programs Accreditation 2024-2025 School Year

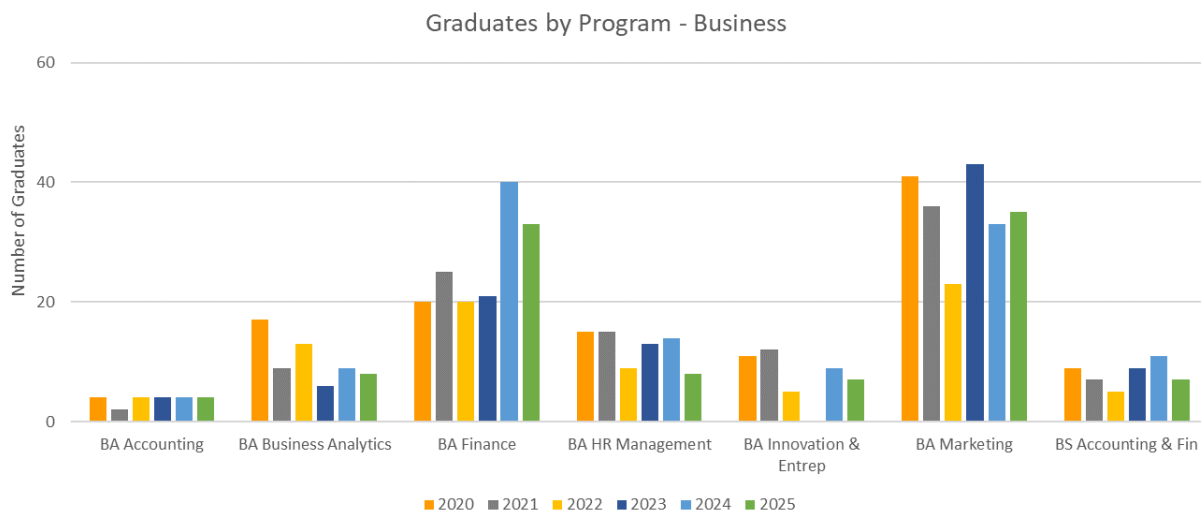
Founded in 1988, the Accreditation Council for Business Schools and Programs (ACBSP) is a global business education accrediting body with 1,200 members in 60 countries. They are the only accreditation organization to offer accreditations at all levels of collegiate business educational degree programs, from associate to doctoral.



ACBSP ignites a standard of excellence with an accreditation process based on the Baldrige Education Criteria for Performance Excellence. By evaluating aspects of a business program's leadership, strategic planning, quality of academic programs, faculty credentials, educational support, and relationship with stakeholders, ACBSP assesses a business program's ability to offer a rigorous educational experience and commit to continuous quality improvement. The goal is to ensure that students gain the skills employers want from their educational investment.

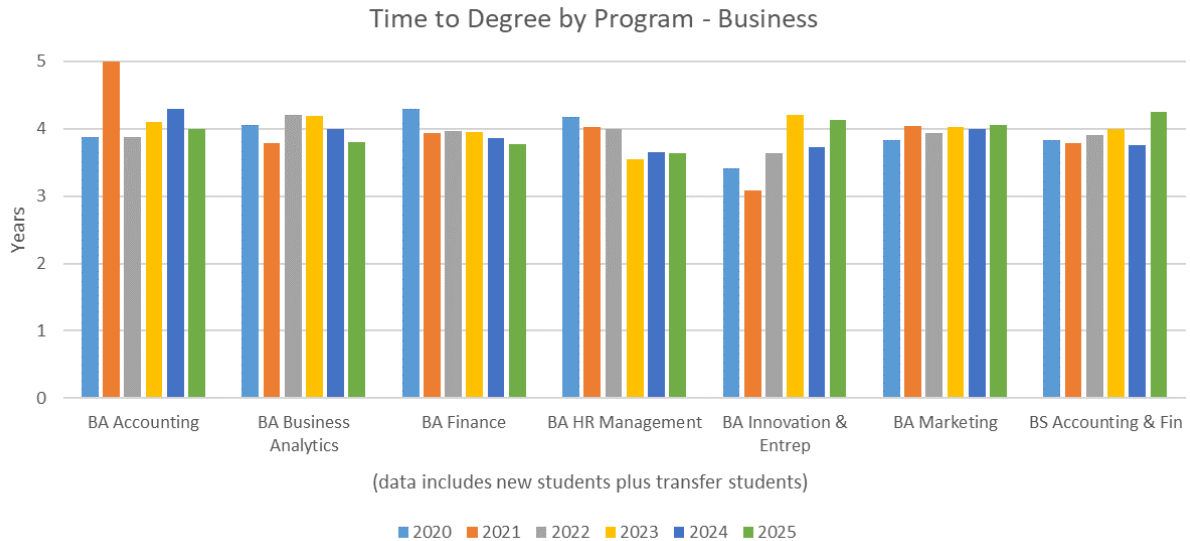
### Business Program Graduates—Bethel University, Department of Business

Accredited programs in the Department of Business produced approximately 20% of the 2025 graduates from Bethel University's baccalaureate students. Following is a breakdown of business graduates by program.



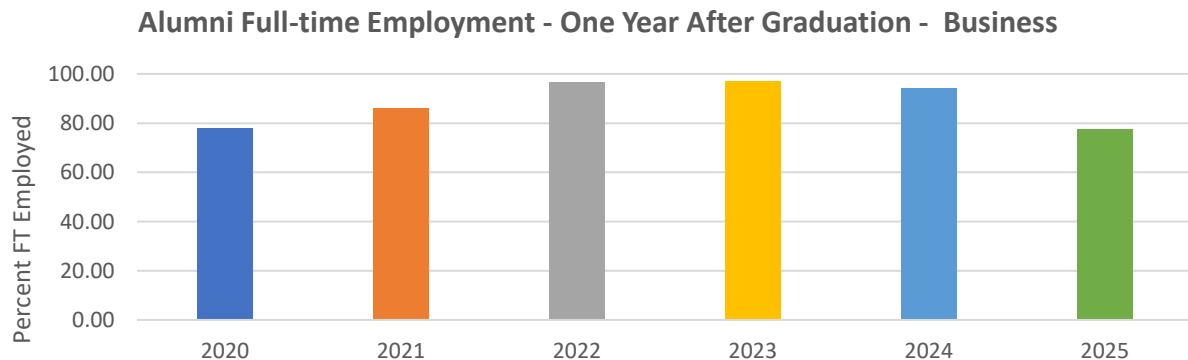
## Business Program Time to Degree—Bethel University, Department of Business

The average time to degree for new students in the Bethel baccalaureate business program is 3.9 years over a six-year period.



## Employment of Business Graduates—Bethel University, Department of Business

In a survey of alumni one year after graduation, an average of 88% of Bethel baccalaureate business graduates reported being employed full-time over a six-year period. Those reporting traditional “full-time” employment in 2025 decreased, while those reporting “self-employment or other” increased from 3% to 18% indicating a potential shift in the workforce.



**Business Student Satisfaction—Bethel University, Department of Business**

In a Bethel Campus Life survey, baccalaureate business students reported an average of 89% overall satisfaction with educational experiences within their business major over a five-year period.
