The Post-Secondary Enrollment Options (PSEO) program is a Minnesota State program allowing high school students to enroll in courses at local cooperating colleges and universities. Through the program, students do not have to pay for college tuition, textbooks, or support services, and cooperating postsecondary institutions receive partial expense reimbursement from the State of Minnesota.

Each year, Bethel admits a limited number of high school seniors through the PSEO program. PSEO students enrolled at Bethel must follow the policies and guidelines outlined below until graduating from high school. Bethel does not necessarily seek state reimbursement for all courses that PSEO students are taking.

General Guidelines for PSEO Student Registration

- Students are required to complete GES140 Intro to Wellbeing and GES160 Inquiry Seminar or GES145 Western Humanities I during their first academic year of participation in the PSEO program at Bethel.
- Students cannot be registered for courses that focus on the Bible or Theological issues (courses with the prefix BIB, THE, or MIN).
- Unless a part of a student's major, students cannot be registered for music, art, or sports courses that have fees of \$30 or greater. Student's whose major requires a course with a fee of \$30 or greater can request special permission to enroll through the Office of the Registrar.
- Students can be registered for no more than 16 credits in a semester and no more than 4 credits in interim
- Students can take 100-level and 200-level classes for which they have met the prerequisites
- A limited number of online courses are available to PSEO students
- Students do not need to pay tuition/academic fees, with the exception of music lessons or trip expenses.
