

This guide is intended for students completing the Psychology A.A. Transfer Pathway. Students who do not intend to complete the 60-credit program should contact <u>Bethel's Transfer Evaluation Specialist</u> for course selection advice. Completing the Minnesota Transfer Curriculum will waive most general education requirements. All courses must be completed with a "C "or better to transfer.
